


BEST BOOKS: Basics of the Faith

READ THE BIBLE, *not just about the Bible. Read some each day starting with something you're familiar with, perhaps one of the Gospels.*




The Narrated Bible (220.5 NARRATED) *Helpful especially for the first time through the Old Testament as it puts everything in historical order, with explanatory "narrations"*

Clarifying the Bible (K-DVD CLARIFYING) 'Big picture' introduction to the Bible, in 20 segments of just a few minutes each, *Showing how all the parts fit together.*



The Essential Bible Companion (220.7 WALTON) *an attractively illustrated introduction to each book of the Bible.*

UNDERSTANDING THE FAITH *Pick a couple of these to start, save the rest for later.*




Basic Training (DVD 238 SPROUL) Six short sessions explaining the Apostles' Creed

What is the Gospel? (230 GILBERT) *Who made us, and to whom are we accountable? What is our problem? What is God's solution to that problem? Why is this good news?*




Core Christianity (230 HORTON) *A theology book that covers all the essentials but is short and to the point!*




The Five Dilemmas of Calvinism (230 BROWN) *Answers common objection such as: if God is both sovereign and good, how can evil things happen?*
