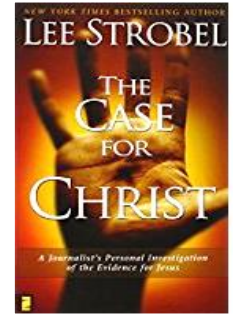
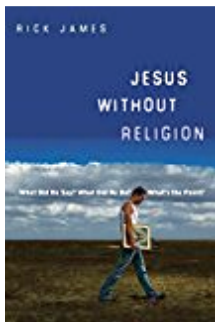


BEST BOOKS: Investigating the Christian Faith

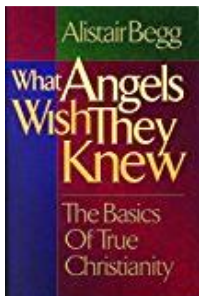
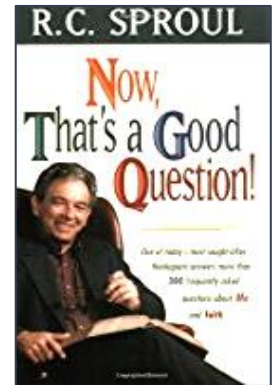

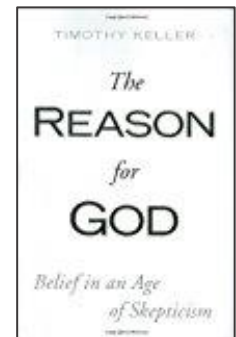
