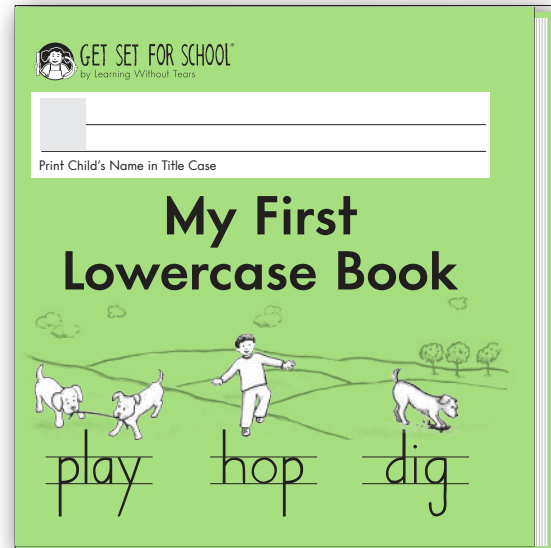
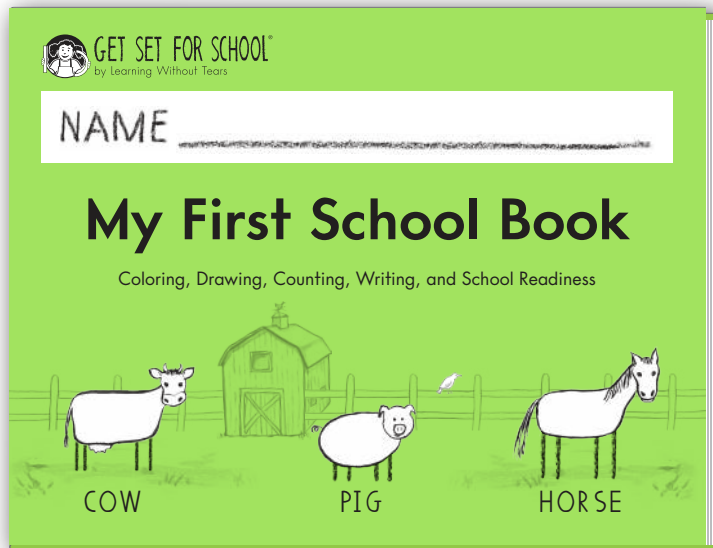




Pre-K Welcome Letter

We are excited about the Get Set for School® Pre-K curriculum we are using this year. This program uses music, art, and multisensory learning materials to prepare children for school in the following learning areas: Language & Literacy, Readiness & Writing, Numbers & Math, Oral Language, and Science & Social Studies.

Your child will be using the award-winning activity book, *My First School Book*, at school. The activity book is used to introduce capital letter and number formations. Towards the end of the year, children will use *My First Lowercase Book* to introduce lowercase letters and prepare them for kindergarten with the goal of writing their name.

During the year, we'll introduce new activities in each of the learning areas. Children will build Mat Man® with Wood Pieces, make letters and numbers with Wood Pieces and dough, and use manipulatives, music, and rhymes to develop strong number sense. We will also explore the world around us with hands-on science and social studies activities.
